### WORD LIST

Actor: Person who performs a dramatic role in a film.

Clip: Short section from a longer work such as a film or play.

Director: Person responsible for creating the overall vision of the film and guiding its production process.

Film: A motion picture, typically shown in a theater or on television.

Genre: Category of film based on similarities in style, theme, subject matter, etc.

Movie: A story told with moving images and sound.

Reel: Long strip of plastic movie film wound onto spools for storage or projection.

Scene: Part of the script that takes place at one location and time.

Theater: Place where films are usually shown to the public.
