Bohemia: Region in former Czechoslovakia

Bratislava: Second largest city in Czechoslovakia

Czechs: Ethnic group from Czechoslovakia

Dubcek: Alexander Dubcek, leader of the 1968 Prague Spring reforms in Czechoslovakia

Habsburg: Former ruling family of the region

Havel: Vaclav Havel, President of post-Communist Czech Republic (formerly part of Czechoslovakia)

Munich: 1938 agreement between Britain, France and Germany to cede Sudetenland to Nazi Germany.

Prague: Capital of Czechoslovakia

Slovaks: Ethnic group from Czechoslovakia

Socialism: Economic system embraced by Communist-era Czechoslovakia

Socialist: Government form in post-WWII Czechoslovakia

Sudeten: German-speaking area in pre-WWII Czechoslovakia

Velvet: Velvet Revolution that ended Communism in 1989
