**Chowmein:** Stir-fried noodles with vegetables and/or meat.

**Congee:** Rice porridge commonly eaten for breakfast in China.

**Dimsum:** Bite-sized appetizers typically enjoyed with tea.

**Dumpling:** Small, savory dish made of dough filled with filling.

**Eggrolls:** Fried pastry stuffed with cabbage and other ingredients.

**Gyoza:** Japanese dumplings filled with ground pork or seafood.

**Kungpao:** Spicy stir-fry dish containing peanuts and chili peppers.

**MooShu:** Stir-fried pork or chicken wrapped in thin pancakes.

**Noodles:** Long, thin strands of dough often served in broth.

**Wonton:** Small dumplings usually served in soup.
