Corn: Crop grown by Native Americans and shared with colonists at the feast.

Feast: Celebration held after the Pilgrims' first harvest in 1621 with Wampanoag people.

Gravy: a sauce made from meat juices

Mashed: Type of potatoes

Pie: dessert with a pastry crust and filling

Pilgrims: English settlers who arrived in North America on the Mayflower.

Pumpkin: pie filling made from squash

Stuffng: seasoned bread cubes used as a side dish

Turkey: a bird served as a traditional main course

Venison: Meat from deer hunted by Native Americans and shared with colonists at the feast.

Wampanoag: Native American tribe living in what is now Massachusetts, Rhode Island and Connecticut.

Yam: sweet potato
