### WORD LIST

**Gospel:** Influential type of African-American spiritual music with origins in the blues tradition.

**Groove:** the sense of timing and feel of the beat in blues music

**Harmony:** Combination of notes to create pleasing sounds in songs.

**Jazz:** Popular genre of music which heavily influenced the blues.

**Lick:** a melodic phrase used as an improvisation

**Licks:** Phrases played over and over by blues guitarists.

**Moan:** vocal sound created by bending pitches, often associated with classic blues singers

**Rhythm:** The beat or tempo of a song.

**Riff:** A short musical phrase repeated throughout a song.

**Shuffle:** A style of playing where beats are broken up into triplets.

**Slide:** Technique used by guitarists to produce gliding sound from one note to another.

**Tonic:** root note of a scale that provides stability in blues music
