WORD LIST

Adagio: slow tempo in classical music.

Allegro: fast, lively tempo in classical music.

Aria: melody sung by a single voice with accompaniment from an orchestra or band.

Cantata: musical composition for choir and instruments.

Concerto: composed piece of music for one or more solo instruments accompanied by an orchestra.

Motif: short musical idea that is repeated throughout a composition to unify it musically.

Opera: theatrical performance combining singing and instrumental music.

Sonata: piece of music for solo instrument or solo instrument with accompaniment.

Symphony: large-scale orchestral work in several movements.
