### WORD LIST

Banjo: stringed instrument often used in country music

Cajun: style of folk music, popularized by Louisiana-based bands

Fiddle: main accompanying instrument in some genres of country music

Guitar: primary lead instrument for many country songs

Hickory: type of wood often used to make the necks of guitars and banjos

Linesman: sound technician needed to record and mix a band's performance

Opryland: famous venue where many big-name acts have performed

Pedal steel: special guitar used in traditional country bands

Yodeler: vocalist who uses a special technique to create high pitched notes
