WORD LIST

Bluesy: mellow sound with a hint of minor tonalities

Bop: 1940s-50s genre of jazz

Chord: harmonic structure in jazz

Dixieland: New Orleans style of jazz

Horns: usually a wind instrument (trumpet, saxophone) used in jazz music

Jive: type of swing dancing done to jazz music

Rhythm: the beat or pulse of the song

Scat: vocal improvisation with nonsense syllables

Shout: call and response style of early jazz

Swing: fast-paced danceable style of jazz

Syncopated: off-beat timing to add complexity and interest to melodies

Vamp: cyclical chordal riff used as a background accompaniment
