WORD LIST

Rockabilly: style of rock and roll popularized in the 1950s.

Beat: Repetitive rhythm.

Drums: Percussion instrument commonly used in rock and roll.

Fuzz: Distortion effect on guitar or bass.

Fuzzy: type of distorted sound produced by electric guitars.

Guitar: stringed instrument used to play rock and roll music.

Horns: Wind instruments often featured in rock and roll songs.

Jam: Musical improvisation.

Jamming: playing together in a relaxed, improvisational setting.

Licks: short melodic phrases that add interest to a song's melody line.

Riffing: creating a musical phrase with repeated notes or chords.

Riffs: Short, catchy musical phrases repeated throughout a song.

Rockers: people who are devoted fans of rock and roll music.

Soloing: instrumental solo performed by individual musician during song.

Vocals: Voice of the singer/band member in a song.
