Foo Fighters: American rock band founded by Nirvana drummer Dave Grohl in 1994.

Fuzz: Distorted sound created by overdriving guitar amplifiers, popularized by psychedelic and garage rock

Grunge: Sub-genre of rock featuring angsty lyrics and distorted guitar sound.

Guitar: Musical instrument used by many rock bands.

Muse: English alt-rock trio that blends elements of classical music with progressive rock.

Oasis: British alternative rock group popularized during the Britpop movement of the 1990s.

Pearl Jam: Pioneers of grunge who achieved mainstream success with albums like Ten and Vs.

Riffing: Repeated musical phrase played on the guitar to create an infectious groove, common in classic bl

Vocals: Lead singer of a band, a staple of rock music.
