### WORD LIST

**Blues:** Early form of soul influenced by spirituals, work songs, and field hollers from West Africa and the Caribbean.

**Funk:** a style of soul characterized by a strong groove and danceable beat.

**Gospel:** religious tunes that are often found in soul music.

**Groove:** an infectious rhythmic pattern that is often felt more than heard when listening to soul music.

**Harmony:** an essential element of many soul songs, creating a rich soundscape with multiple voices or instruments.

**Lyrics:** words used to express the emotion of soul music.

**Motown:** iconic record label based in Detroit, Michigan which produced some of the most influential soul artists.

**Rhythm:** the foundation for most soul music, providing structure and drive to the song's melody and lyrics.

**Soul:** Genre of African American music that combines elements of gospel and rhythm and blues.

**Vocals:** Leading instrument in soul music featuring powerful singing.
